Privacy Policy

Selsey Golf Club(the Club) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. For any personal data you provide for the purpose of your membership, the Club is the data controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure, and transparent way.

What Personal Data do we hold on you?

You may give us information by filling in forms at an event or online or by corresponding with us by phone, email or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you register with the Club. The information you give us may include your name, address, phone number, bank details for membership fees, other golf clubs you may be a member at and your current handicap.

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need your personal data is to be able to administer your membership and provide the membership services you are signing up to when you register with the Club. Our lawful basis for processing your personal data is that we have a legitimate interest in you as a member to provide the services you are registering for.

Reasons we need to process your data include

For membership and Club management

- Processing membership forms and payments
- Sharing data with the Club committee to provide information about members and renewals, resignations or numbers attending a social event
- Informing members about policies and procedures to meet our legal obligations
- Club news and website information for promoting the Club
- Taking entries for open competitions and allocating tee times
- Notifying Members about Team events
- Publishing of competition results
- Online booking information for tee times and advertising availability of the golf course
- Advertising social events to the membership
- Notifying members of late changes to schedules events



Who the Club shares your personal data with

The Club may share your personal data with officers of the Club for the purposes of administering the Club. Selsey Country Club for purposes of collecting annual fees. Competition results are entered onto 'Master Scoreboard' data base and handicap information is shared with England Golf, and Sussex County Golf Union and the Sussex County Ladies Golf Association.

The Club does not share or transfers your personal data outside the UK

How long will the Club hold your personal data?

We will hold your personal data on file as long as you are a member with the Club. Any personal data we hold on you will be destroyed after five years of inactivity. Your personal data is not processed for any further purposes other than those detailed in this policy.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may at any time request access to , rectify or erasure of your personal data, to restrict or object to certain types of processing of your data, to the portability, of your personal data and to complain to the UK Data Protection Supervisory Authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.

As a data subject you are not obliged to share your personal data with the Club. If you choose not to share your personal data with the Club, we may not be able to register or administer your membership.
